

CENTURY TOWERS

2220 & 2222 Avenue of the Stars

Built in 1964, the Century Towers were originally designed as apartments by world renowned architect I.M. Pei. Perhaps best known for the “Pyramide du Louvre,” his landmark glass pyramid addition to the Louvre Museum (Paris, France,) Pei brought his signature clean-lined, modern styling to the creation of the Towers. Perfectly positioned at the corner of Pico Boulevard & Avenue of the Stars, his powerful, imposing structures have become the symbolic gateway to Century City.

Originally conceived and built with materials which were considered “high-tech” for the day and age, the Towers remain a significant example of timeless contemporary architecture even in today’s landscape of cutting-edge design. The Towers were converted to condominiums in 1972 and since have retained a reputation as the superior address of choice in Century City’s thriving world of luxury condominium living.

Poised on 6 acres of land, the Towers are comprised of one, two, and three bedroom single story residences on 28 floors, featuring spectacular views of the city, ocean, mountain, and golf course; a cornucopia feast for the eyes of twinkling lights, shimmering water, and rolling greens.
